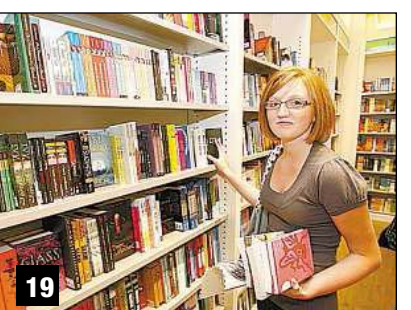
A browser's paradise
